First Half Term "TRANSPORTATION". (L.O: To talk/learn about the modes of transportation)

Second Half term theme: "ANIMALS"



"ANIMALS" (L.O: To learn and talk about different animals and their habitats)

Week 8: Introduction of the theme - "Animals". Do you have a pet animal?

Week 9: Farm animals are helpful

Week 10: Sea/Aquatic animals

Week 11: Wild animals in the Jungle- Have you been to a zoo?

Week 12: Dinosaurs and the Extinct.

Week 13: Recap

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED) -

- We will encourage the children to use words to solve disagreements instead of being unkind. They will also learn to appreciate their own and others' needs.
- Show acceptance of the needs of others and show care for others and for living things and he environment
- Seek out others to share experience, linking up for guidance and support
- We will explore and talk about how community helpers can help us.
- The children will try out new activities and learn to select resources independently.
- We will talk about sharing and working as a team using some books.
- We will also talk about listening to instructions and responding to them.
- We will learn the ground rules: being helpful, kind, hardworking, sharing, gentle touch and taking turns
- We will encourage the children to practice good table manners (feet under the table, eating without talking and asking for permission to leave the table when done.)
- We will learn some basic life skills such as: tidying up after ourselves, folding our clothes neatly and taking care of our personal belongings during swimming and caring for the environment.
- We will encourage the children to do little jobs for the teacher and their friends, such as laying the table mats and water bottles during snack time.
- Say hello to their friends and wait for a response, then use magic words.

Communication and Language:

- The children will build up their vocabularies using words to express or elaborate on ideas. Words such as: on foot, car, plane, bus, bicycle, taxi, truck, van, subway. The children will also learn how to follow directions by listening carefully
- The children will be encouraged to use words to describe safety: on the road: obeying traffic lights, using the zebra crossing. They will also be expected to show a level of understanding of a story they listened to, talk about the principal characters and the sequence of events in the story.
- The children will learn to follow simple and two-part instructions, also respond to the 'why' and 'how' questions. For example, they will learn to explain why some wild animals cannot be kept as pets.
- Use talk to give meaning, to explain & to connect ideas
- Build up vocabulary & use widening range of words
- Show interest, hold & handle books correctly & carefully
- We will talk about how to work things out instead of acting out.
- Listening and acting out favourite stories as a small group.

Literacy

- The children will learn to recognize, trace, copy and write own names
- They will learn how to hold the books the correct way up and turn pages and handle books carefully.
- They will begin to identify and write the sounds from sets 1.
- They will also learn to blend learned sounds correctly to form words.

MD (Numeracy) for the year

- Counting and recognizing number of cars we can find around the school 1-10
- Identifying and writing number of items I can see 1-10
- Naming and identifying 2D shapes found in the classroom and corridors.
- Counting, tracing and writing numbers 1-20

- Matching numbers with objects 1-10
- Using positional words to describe parts of the tree and seasons, such as-behind, after, before, later, next to, on top of, under etc.
- Use size language of 'bigger than', 'enough', heavy and light, fast and slow.

Knowledge and Understanding (UW)

- Observing and talking about the different modes of transportation.
- Talk about the different types of animals and where they live.
- Discuss road safety and how the police officer can help us.
- Discuss how to care for our pets
- Use role-play to explore how we can be hardworking and helpful in our community.
- Talk about how to board a plane or a train

Physical Development (PD)

- Learn how to use 1-handed tools & manipulate with increasing control & co-ordination and introduce new
 equipment and how to use them properly, e.g-scissors and stapler.
- Learn how to tie knots using laces.

- Learn how to walk downstairs with two feet to each step whilst carrying something small.
- Begin to balance on one foot for a short time.
- Learn to catch a large ball.
- Repeat patterns and action in rhymes and finger play
- Move with control and co-ordination in a range of ways in time to music.
- Jump off a height and land properly.
- Use the writing materials correctly and observe the texture of things.
- Learn to put on the coat and shoes correctly, zip and unzip our bags properly.
- Learn to wash and dry hands independently. Children will be playing games to develop their awareness of space in P.E. and the outside area.
- Explore ways of travelling under, over and through with a focus on linking movements.

Creative Development

- Begin to describe the texture of things, explore experiences using range of senses
- Join in with songs, sing to selves & make up own songs.
- Tap out rhythms & explore how sounds can be changed
- Use body language to express feelings

- Create movement in response to sounds & music, develop repertoire of actions & put sequence of movements together
- Use resources to support imaginative role play
